Lesson Title:	R-Controlled Vowels: ar, ir, ur		
Grade Level(s):	Grade 2	Lesson Duration:	30 Minutes

Lesson Objectives

After completing the lesson the students will be able to:

- identify and complete words with the r-controlled vowels "ar," "ir," and "ur," enhancing their decoding and spelling skills.

Summary of Tasks/Actions

- Introduce the concept of r-controlled vowels, explaining how the "r" changes the vowel sound. Write the r-controlled vowels "ar," "ir," and "ur" on the board.
- Provide examples of words with "ar," "ir," and "ur" (e.g., "car," "bird," "turn") and discuss the sounds they make. Show pictures of objects that correspond to the words.
- Explain that students will complete words on their worksheet using "ar," "ir," and "ur". Distribute the worksheets to students.
- Model completing the first word on the worksheet with the class, discussing why the specific r-controlled vowel is used.
- Instruct students to look at the pictures and complete the remaining words on their own. Allow students to work independently on their worksheets.
- Circulate to provide assistance and encouragement.
- Review the completed worksheets as a class, discussing the correct answers and the sounds of the r-controlled vowels.

Ask students to find three words at home that contain r-controlled vowels ("ar," "ir," or "ur") and write them down. Bring their list to class to share with their peers.
