Editing for Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling

Editing for Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling means reviewing and correcting writing to make it clear, correct, and easy to read. In Grade 5, students are expected to spot and fix:

- •Grammar errors (e.g., subject-verb agreement, verb tense, pronoun use)
- •Punctuation errors (e.g., missing periods, commas, quotation marks)
- •Spelling mistakes (e.g., commonly confused or misspelled words)

Editing is the step in the writing process that comes **after drafting and revising**—it ensures the final piece is polished and correct.

'■ Example

Before Editing:

my freind go to the store they was looking for apple's and juice

After Editing:

My friend went to the store. They were looking for apples and juice.

Corrections:

- Capitalized "My"
- Corrected spelling of "friend"
- •Fixed verb tense: "go" → "went"; "was" → "were"
- •Removed apostrophe from "apple's" (not possessive)
- •Added period to separate two sentences
